O/24/010 REVIEW AND DECIDE ACTION ON MATTERS RAISED BY COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.

The Committee Chairman informed members that he had 3 points for discussion:

- a. The presence of Japanese Knotweed on private land at the Model Village. He explained how the owner of the land was unaware of its presence and there is little we can do about it.
- b. One A-Frame on the recreation ground needs modification and after some discussion it was agreed that Cllr. D Smith would seek quotes for remedial work.
- c. Fly tipping on private land on Sookholme which the Committee Chairman considers to be potentially hazardous. Some discussion took place and Cllr Dale said she would raise the matter with the County Council.

Though this was not a meeting where public speaking was allowed, the Committee Chairman invited the members of the public to speak. They wanted to ask for permission to be allowed to maintain the burial ground of their relative and to ask for reimbursement for pots they had placed into the burial ground which had been subsequently damaged. Some discussion took place, and it was decided further investigation was required.

The public member went on to ask if we could do anything about the nuisance behaviour from residents of the old Station Hotel. The Committee Chairman agreed to meet with the resident to try and assist them in submitting a complaint.
